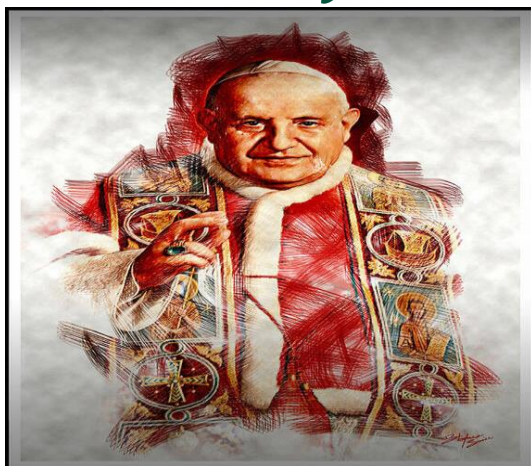

FROM THE PARISH ADMINISTRATOR: “What is needed at the present time is a new enthusiasm, a new joy and serenity of mind in the unreserved acceptance by all.” Pope John XXIII spoke these words in his opening address of the first session of the Second Vatican Council. Through the council, His Holiness, our parish patron, called for the Church to respond to the challenges of the day in finding new ways and a new energy to proclaim the Gospel to all people. The legacy of living our Catholic faith is strong in the Niles community. Rich in traditions and customs, worship and service, all rooted in a love of God and neighbor – in every generation the Church of Niles has been called to rise to the occasion of being Christ for one another. Different paths and different journeys have led us collectively to this day. In the spirit of Saint Pope John XXIII, we are invited to throw open the windows of the Church and let the Light of Christ in. That radiant light demonstrates clearly that we must come together to strengthen the community of believers here in Niles. While we will always be enriched and guided by the examples of Our Lady, the first and greatest of disciples, and Saint Stephen, the first to shed his blood for the faith – today, Saint Paul, in the second reading, reminds us to “show no partiality”. Regardless of yesterday, we are one parish today – and must work to grow as such in order to achieve our tomorrows. I am humbled that Bishop Bonnar has asked me to serve as the administrator who will lead the parish in achieving this great goal of uniting together. In all honesty, this is a community where people work together, learn together, celebrate together, mourn together, care for the poor among us together. We live next door to each other, so it only stands to reason that with a little effort and great excitement for what can be – we can worship our God and serve in his name together. Over the next few weeks, I will be calling together a new council of dedicated members who have but one agenda – to see the Parish of Saint Pope John XXIII become a vibrant beacon of hope for our community. This council will assist in developing a framework for the future. I want to stress that both campuses – Saint Stephen and Our Lady of Mount Carmel are remaining open for both Sunday and Weekday worship, along with other sacramental celebrations. We will also work to create a calendar that celebrates parish wide the various activities and events that were once unique to the previous two parishes. At this point, I am postponing the beginning of the Catechetical year until the first Sunday of October to allow us time to prepare a unified program for the children of the parish. I know full well that we will all slip from time to time and revert to “Saint Stephen” or Mount Carmel” when referring to ourselves, the parish, or the activities and ways of the past. This is understandable as an “old habit”. But we must work very hard to come to now see ourselves as “Saint Pope John XXIII Parish”. We have so many blessings to build upon for the future – let us not be buried in the past, but rather, rise to the newness of light. On behalf of Father Marneni, who you will meet at all the Masses next weekend, God bless you all. Father Lavelle

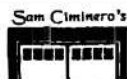
